This year MCAW offers a maximum of five weeks of summer camps. Summer session begins Monday, June 29 through Thursday, July 30th. Program activities are offered on 4 days – Monday to Thursday. MCAW offers you the flexibility to design your child’s camp experience. Programs range from a single weekly ‘PM Choice’ class to a maximum full day program. Participants can enroll for a minimum of one week up to the entire five-week term.

MCAW SUMMER CAMP

Young Campers (ages 5-12) meet **four hours each day (1/2 day including lunch)**, or **five and one half hours each day (full day) Monday through Thursday** at the school. Each day includes a short snack break and lunch in the cafeteria. After lunch, campers have a chance to participate in a variety of 45 minute classes offered as PM Choices. **PM Choices** are conducted between **1:00pm and 2:30pm Monday to Thursday** and include: music, band, taekwon do, chess & challenges, science, crafts and more. Children may also enroll in PM Choice classes independently of the camps. On the last day of camp we hold a reception to celebrate the creations, performances and the friends we’ve made.

Older Campers (ages 13-16) meet **four hours each day (1/2 day including lunch)** for science only, **one and one half hours each day (1:00-2:30pm)** for band or art or **five and one half hours each day(Theater Camp only) Monday through Thursday** at the school. One PM Choice is offered as well between **1:00 and 2:30pm Monday to Thursday**.

ART CAMP (HALF DAY) AGES 5-7 & 8-12

WEEKLY ART THEMES

Each week of the five-week program is self-contained with an explicit theme. Designed to provide participants with flexible enrollment options – students can enroll for a minimum of one week or maximum of the entire term (5 weeks). The 5 to 7 year old camps are geared for younger artists and may include stories and crafts. The 8 to 15 year old camps are for older artists to explore more advanced arts techniques. Class size is limited to 12 so that each student receives plenty of attention.

The weekly themes are:

Week I SEA ADVENTURES! June 29 - July 2

Welcome to the world's most beautiful coral reefs. Swim to an under sea cave, discover missing treasure! Our masterpiece can include sea urchins, wondrous animals, island people, and creatures that live above and below the sea.

Week II MYSTERIES OF EGYPT July 6 - July 9

Come discover the world of ancient Egypt. During this week you will create art inspired by the pyramids, mummies, hieroglyphs & pharaohs of ancient Egypt.

Week III WONDROUS ANIMALS July 13 - July 16

Go wild while developing your drawing & painting skills. This week draw wild, endangered, and extinct animals and/or animals from your own imagination. Learn about anatomy, creating form, texture and tone using a variety of drawing materials.

Week IV AFRICAN ART July 20 – July 23

This week travel through the beautiful land of Africa. Learn about traditions and celebrations and create your own masterpiece inspired by African art weaving, masks & pottery.

Week V CLAY & CARTOONS July 27 – July 30

Learn to draw your own fun and unique cartoon characters and creatures. Draw funny faces, strange aliens, and hilarious animals and make your own comic strip. Create your cartoon creatures with clay!

DANCE CAMP (HALF DAY)

Week I, II & III Ages 5-7

Week IV & V Ages 8-12

This summer MCAW offers summer dance camp in ballet, Jazz hip-hop, modern dance & making dances. In addition to technique classes, this camp blends basic dance steps, movement, music & improvisation. It is an excellent introduction for the future study of dance techniques. Students learn fundamentals while developing their imagination.

MUSIC CAMP (HALF DAY)

Week I, II, III, IV & V Ages 5-7

For beginners only! Learn the basics of playing the guitar & percussion. Each week will also include an added instrument to explore: Week I & II will include singing, Week III-violin. Week IV-Dalcroze (music & movement) & Week V-cello.

NEW! SCIENCE CAMP (HALF DAY)

Week I & Week II Ages 8-12

Physics & Engineering I! Experiment with laws of physics and develop new skills. Engineer towers, bridges and domes. Make a propeller-driven car and build and launch your own fuel rocket. Invent something new.

NEW! THEATER CAMP

This camp is a full day camp (9am to 2:30pm).
Students must attend both weeks.

Week I & II Ages 8-12

This camp is for those who want to stretch their acting & musical skills. Students will spend two weeks learning various aspects of musical theater through the participation and creation of an actual production. Students will study acting, performance technique, movement, dance voice and technical theater. A final production will be performed on the last day of camp for family and friends.

NEW! BAND CAMP

This camp runs from 1:00pm to 2:30pm. Students must attend both weeks.

Week I, II Ages 10+

For students who have had a minimum of one and a half years of instrument lessons. Students will learn the basics of ensemble playing and how to start their own band. The group will be divided into smaller ensembles based on instrumentation and ability and learn relevant repertoire as a band. Elements of improvisation through blues scales and related music theory will be covered. Each band will have a chance to perform their pieces at the end of this two week session.

PM CHOICES

Ages 5-7 & 8-12

Two PM Choices are available beginning at 1pm (after lunch). Each class is conducted from Monday to Thursday (four days). Students may choose from a variety of classes. Choose one or two 45 minutes long classes:

NEW! BOOT CAMP

Ages 5-7 1:00pm to 1:43pm

Ages 8-12 1:45pm to 2:27pm

Become more fit, build self confidence and learn to succeed. This boot camp is 45 minutes of non-competitive fitness that combines gymnastics, strength training, flexibility, games and cardiovascular training in, structured closely supervised environment.

TAE KWON DO**Ages 5-7 1:45pm to 2:27pm****Ages 8-12 1:00pm to 1:43pm**

Develop self discipline and respect, increase your focus, and build confidence as you learn martial arts. This program teaches students basic martial arts, self defense techniques, Platoni's kid's safe program will help make them bully proof.

TAP DANCING**Ages 5-7 1:45pm to 2:27pm**

This class is for boys & girls who like to dance and learn to tap! Students will have fun learning different routines choreographed and stylized using pop and traditional music.

CHESS**Ages 5-7 1:00pm to 1:43pm****Ages 8-12 1:45pm to 2:27pm**

Learn the value of strategy. This class is open to beginners as well as students looking to improve and fine tune their game. Beginners will learn the basic tactics of chess while more advanced students will test their mental capacity of the game and work on their strategy in a game format.

JEWELRY MAKING**Week IV & V Ages 5-7 1:00 to 1:43pm****Week IV & V Ages 8-12 1:45 to 2:27pm**

Make handmade jewelry! Create beautiful necklaces, bracelets, anklets, earrings, and much more using only the best and highest quality beads. Some jewelry techniques taught during class: weaving, bead stringing, Wig Jig, wire wrapping & design principals.

MUSIQ CLUB**Ages 5-7 1:00pm to 1:43pm**

For beginners only, learn to play the piano with both hands, read music, improvise and compose with MusIQ Club. Students progress from level to level, at their own pace each term advancing their musical skills. A great way to prepare for semi or private lessons!

**CAMPS AND CLASSES
AGES 13-16****ART CAMP**

Art camps for this age group are conducted from 1:00 to 2:30pm.

Week I EVERYTHING ABSTRACT! June 29 - July 2

Express yourself in new ways! Use bold colors, fanciful shapes and crafty lines to depict emotion and energy. Create colorful expressive paintings, wild patterned portraits & imaginative layered collages.

Week II CLAY ART July 6 - July 9

Explore the wonderful medium of clay. Primitive style pottery, musical pieces and wall art are just a few of the sculptural projects we will be making. Stoneware and earthenware will be kiln fired and clay projects will air dry. Kiln firing and material fee included.

Week III CARTOONING July 13 - July 16

Draw fun and unique cartoon characters and creatures. As you create your own comic strip, you will learn how to draw funny faces, strange aliens and hilarious animals. Create your own action book using animation techniques.

Week IV LANDSCAPES July 20 - July 23

This course is for students who enjoy the excitement and beauty of the outdoors. Students will use a variety of materials, including an assortment of paint, pens, pastels and papers and venture outdoors to create preliminary landscape sketches. Back in the art room they will complete their landscape masterpiece.

Week V JUST DRAWING July 27 - July 30

Learn the basic skills of drawing from observation while working from still-life and the human figure. Work with a variety of drawing media including graphite, charcoal and ink. Students will use the practice of drawing to discover and develop their own ideas.

NEW! PHOTOGRAPHY CAMP

Photography camp is from 1:00pm to 2:30pm.

Week II

Express yourself through photography! Share ideas and feelings. Students will investigate how light affects form, color and composition. Learn about visual composition, flash and non-flash photography and photograph outdoor landscape scenes and wildlife. Bring your digital camera and camera manual, if available to class.

NEW! COOKING CAMP

Cooking camp is from 1:00pm to 2:30pm.

Week III

This week explore basic cooking techniques! Make homemade dough and create your own "Pain au Chocolate". "Bake a French Pie Crust from Scratch" and make a delicious "Tart aux Pommes" Prepare simple recipes from pies to pizza's using just a toaster oven.

NEW! BAND CAMP

Band Camp is from 1:00pm to 2:30pm.

(Students must attend both weeks).

Week I, II

Learn the basics of ensemble playing and how to play in a band. Gain experience communicating with musicians who play other instruments. Create your own rock band arrangements. Groups will be divided into smaller ensembles based on instrumentation and ability. They will learn relevant repertoire. Elements of improvisation through blues scales and related music
